

TOURISM IN PAHARI REGION

Pahari regions including Uttarakhand, Himachal Predesh and Jammu & Kashmir are renowned for its Pilgrim heritage, breathtaking landscapes, adventure tourism and rich culture. Uttrakhand is home to the Char Dham Yatra (Badrinath, Kedarnath, Gangotri and Yamunotri), the Ganga Aarti at Haridwar and yoga capital Rishikesh. Additionally, the state boasts serene hill stations like Nainital, Mussoorie and Auli, diverse wildlife in Jim Corbett National Park and trekking trails in Chopta, Valley of Flowers and Roopkund. While as the Himachal Pradesh is hotspot of Heavenly tourist like Khajjiar, Shimla, Manali, Spiti, Dalhousie, Kaza, Dharamshala, Palampur, Tosh lie in the lap of Himachal Pradesh. Another prominent Pahahri region (Pir panjal) is home to several tourist destinations like Amarnath Yatra, Mata Vaishno Devi, Noori Chamb, Peer Ki Gali, Kalka Mata Temple, Shahdara Sharif, Pahalgam, Gulmarg, Bangus Valley, Tosaimadan, Kheer Bhawani (Kupwara), Lolab Valley, Gurez Valley, Drung Waterfall, Wular Lake, Keran Valley, Karnah Valley, Sadhna Pass, Teetwal, Sharda Peeth Route (Historic Trek).
